Bealtaine an tSamhraidh

Tá Mí na Bealtaine beagnach buailte linn agus aimsir álainn ghrianmhar geallta, tá súil againn, mar chruthú go bhfuil laethanta fada an tSamhraidh ag síneadh amach ós ár gcomhair. 'Séard is brí le Bealtaine ná Béal Tine mar bhíodh Tinte Cnámh ag na Ceiltigh chun fáiltiú roimh an samhraidh. Glaoití Lá Buí Bealtaine ar an gcéad lá de Bhealtaine... buíú na gréine agus teacht an tSamhraidh.

Mí thábhachtach i bhféilire na gCeilteach ab ea Bealtaine. Roinn na Ceiltigh an bhliain ina dhá chuid – an leath dorcha agus an leath geal. Cosúil len a lán ciníocha eile, thosaigh an bhliain leis an tráth
